

## **ALESSANDRO BUFALINI**

Alessandro Bufalini is Assistant Professor of International Law at the University of Tuscia. Previously, he was Research Fellow in International Law at the same University (2017-2019). Before joining the University of Tuscia, he was post-doc researcher at the University of Milano-Bicocca (2014-2016). He holds a degree in law (cum laude) from the University of Bologna and a PhD from the University of Macerata in International and European Union Law (with a dissertation on The Modes of Individual Criminal Responsibility under International Law).

Alessandro Bufalini teaches Public International Law (2014 – present) and European Migration Law (2020 – present) at University of Tuscia and was Lecturer of Migration Law at the University of Macerata (2013/14). He has been invited as visiting professor at the Université Catholique de Lille, where he has been teaching a course on Global Governance (2019/2020 and 2020/2021), and at the V. N. Karazin Kharkiv National University, holding a course of EU Migration Law, within the context of a Jean Monnet Module.

He is currently assistant editor of QIL-Questions of International Law, one of the leading international academic journals in the field of public international law. He is also member of the Editorial Committee of the ADiMBlog and acts as reviewer and referee for a number of academic journals.

Over the last years, he has been Visiting Fellow at the University of Paris 1 Panthéon-Sorbonne, the Amsterdam Center for International Law, the Max Planck Institute for Foreign and International Criminal Law in Freiburg, the Institute for Advanced Legal Studies in London and the Max Planck Institute for Comparative Public Law and
