Mario Savino (1976) is full professor of administrative law at Tuscia University of Viterbo (Italy), where he is also Director of the Graduate Law Program. He is the founder and coordinator of the Italian “Academy of Law and Migration” (*Accademia Diritto e Migrazioni – ADiM*). He graduated *cum laude* in Law at the University of Rome “Sapienza” (1999), where he received a doctorate in administrative law (2004). He has been Global Crystal Eastman Research Fellow at New York University School of Law (Fall semester 2006 and Spring semester 2009), UE Law Poros Chair Professor at National Law School of India University, Bangalore (Summer session 2005) and Research Fellow at the Max Planck Institute for Comparative Public Law and International Law di Heidelberg (2014).

Author of two monographs – on public order and aliens’ freedoms (*Le libertà degli altri. La regolazione amministrativa dei flussi migratori*, Giuffrè, 2012) and on the EU committee system (*I comitati dell’Unione europea*, Giuffrè, 2005) – he recently edited books on the EU migration and asylum policy (*Per una credibile politica europea dell’immigrazione e dell’asilo*, Fondazione Basso, 2018), on the management of the migration crisis in Italy (*La crisi migratoria tra Italia e Unione europea: diagnosi e prospettive*, Editoriale scientifica, 2017), and on nationality legislation in comparative perspective (*Oltre lo ius soli. La cittadinanza italiana in prospettiva comparata*, 2014). He has published extensively, in English and Italian, on immigration and asylum law, European and global administrative law, EU comitology, administrative reforms, transparency and access to public information.
